

<b>PCDP Public Use Datasets: 2002</b>			
<b>Introduction:</b>	The PECARN Core Data Project (PCDP) database is a collection of basic epidemiological information about ED patient visits from participating hospitals within the Pediatric Emergency Care Applied Research Network (PECARN). Data were submitted electronically by each participating ED annually, and processed and stored by the Data Coordinating Center. It is important to note that these datasets are electronically available administrative data. Also, not all sites were able to provide all data elements. Site and patient-level identifiers have been removed from or masked in the public use dataset.		
<b>Inclusion/Exclusion:</b>	All patients 18 years of age and younger presenting to a participating PECARN Emergency Department (ED) during the study period are included.		
<b>Sites:</b>	25 PECARN Emergency Departments		
<b>Identifiers:</b>	Identifiers include VisitID and PatientID. VisitID is unique across all datasets and identifies a single ED visit. PatientID identifies all visits with the same patient identifier provided by the site, or visits for the same patient identified in a probabilistic linkage analysis.		
<b>Datasets:</b>	PCDP_PUD_2002.TXT includes comma-separated PCDP data from year 2002. The SAS program PCDP PUD readin.sas along with the accompanying sas format library may be used to import the data and create a sas dataset with labels and formats.

VisitID	Visit identifier	<b>Numeric (integer)</b>	A randomly generated number that uniquely identifies each visit.
PatientID	Patient identifier	<b>Numeric (integer)</b>	Unique (masked) patient identifier according to probabilistic linkage and the patient identifier provided by the site. This identifier may be used to track multiple visits for a given patient.
Sex	Sex	<b>\$SEX</b> 'M' = Male 'F' = Female

ArrivalHour	Hour of arrival	<b>Numeric (integer)</b>	Calculated based on arrival/triage time.
ArrivalToDischargeMinutes	Minutes from arrival to discharge	<b>Numeric (integer)</b>	Calculated based on arrival/triage date and time and discharge date and time. Values < 0 were considered invalid and removed.

DX1-15	ICD-9 Diagnosis Code 1-15	<b>Character</b>	15 columns in the dataset. The general format for diagnosis codes is XXX.XX

CPT1-15	CPT Procedure Code 1-15	<b>Character</b>	15 columns in the dataset. The general format for CPT codes is XXXXX
Proc1-15	ICD-9 Procedure Code 1-15	<b>Character</b>	15 columns in the dataset. The general format for Procedure codes is XX.XX
Code_validity	Validity of Diagnosis, Procedure, and E-Codes	<b>CODEVALID</b> 1 Valid 0 Invalid: Codes are a mixture of ED and Inpatient Codes	Some sites were only able to supply the diagnosis, procedure (ICD-9 or CPT), and E-codes from the combined ED visit and hospital stay.
